REMINDERS

--Don't forget to obtain a building permit for any structure you plan to build, alter, or change prior to the commencement of the project. Pick up at City Office.

--Be a responsible pet owner: Keep your animals leashed and on your own property. When walking your pets, respect others' property by picking up the "deposits" they may leave along the way.
--For dogs found running at large please call Sioux County Law Enforcement (737-2280) to report dogs running at large within the community or on your property.
--Property Clean-Up: Please assess your property for compliance.

Dumping of Grass/Leaves/Tree Branches

The City will again be offering free dumping of grass clippings, leaves, and tree branches to the west of the City Shed (north end of Main St.). The bins are clearly marked so please dump accordingly. **Do not leave plastic garbage bags with grass/leaves.**

- Dumping of grass and leaves onto city streets is strictly prohibited by City Code.
- The City does not pick up branches off of private property unless they are a result of storm damage. Otherwise, property owners are responsible for hauling their own branches to the dumping site at the City Shed.
- If you are having large trees or limbs removed by a professional at your property, the City will open the Tree Dump on the south side of town for the contractor. Please contact the City Office with questions.

Winners will be notified by May 10, 2021, and announced to the public by May 14.

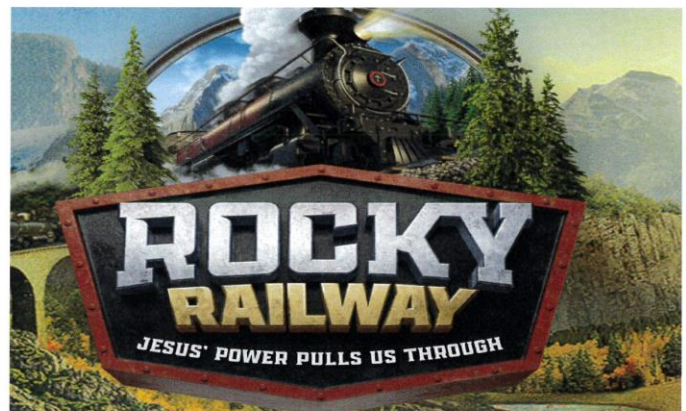

SPRING CITY WIDE CLEANUP

April 29th, 2021

City of Boyden Residents:

Allowable items: normal household trash and home cleanup, furniture, wood items, mattresses, and carpets.

Non-allowable items: Building/remodeling materials, wood chips, auto parts (tires, batteries, etc.), concrete, steel/iron, yard waste, tree branches, oil, yard chemicals, or wet paints.

For Non-Allowable items: Contact **NW Iowa Landfill at (712)324-4026**, to get options for proper disposal of these items.



NO Special Pick-Ups Available!

Must contact the NW Iowa Landfill, for the items listed below.

We Will NOT collect:

Tires, Batteries, Concrete, Paint, Steel, Iron, Yard Waste, House or Lawn Chemicals, or Construction/Shingles.

NO Electronics: TV's, All Computer Components (printers, monitors, keyboards, mouse(s), and CPU's, etc.).

NO White Goods: Stoves, Water heaters, Washer/Dryer, Microwaves, Humidifier/Dehumidifiers, Air Conditioners, Refrigerators/Freezers.

If you have any allowable items to be picked up you need to purchase a \$10.00 flag from the City Office prior to clean up day. If you do not purchase a flag your items will not be picked up.

If you have any White Goods or Electronics to get rid of, you need to call OC Sanitation (712-737-2645) or the City Office (712-725-2371) prior to clean up day, to have it scheduled and paid for in advance.
