Minutes of Special Council Meeting
February 28, 2020

Mayor Laryl Koerselman called the meeting to order at 7:00 am.

Council members present were Robin Jungers, Justin Beukelman, and Dale Winter, and Nathan Alexander. Kim Ochsendorf was absent.

Others present were Craig Van Meeteren and Peter Roos with Mid-American and city employee Tami Kamies.

Mayor Koerselman opened the public hearing at 7:00 am.

Council member Beukelman introduced Resolution 2020-08 to adopt the annual budget for fiscal year ending June 30,2021. There was no citizens present, therefore there was no written or oral comments regarding the proposed budget. Council member Winter seconded the motion to adopt. Roll call vote taken 4-0. Adoption of FY2021 Budget passed and approved.

Council member Jungers introduced Resolution 2020-09 to approve applying for a USDA Grant with intent to help purchase a new warning siren. There was no citizens present, therefore there was no written or oral comments. Council member Alexander seconded the motion to approve. Roll call vote 4-0. Motion to approved was passed.

Mayor Koerselman closed the public hearing at 7:10 am.

Craig & Peter proposed to the city that Mid-American would like to reposition the street lights along highway 18 from the North side of the road to the South side of the road. They also would like to reposition the lights on the south end of main street. Alexander made a motion to allow Mid-American to make the changes to these lights. Beukelman supported. Motion carried 4-0.

With no further business Jungers made a motion to adjourn the meeting. Winter supported. Motion carried 4-0. Meeting was adjourned at 7:20 am.
