Minutes of Monthly Council Meeting

May 10, 2021

Mayor Laryl Koerselman called the meeting to order at 5:31 p.m.

Council members present were Robin Jungers, Justin Beukelman, and Nathan Alexander.

Councilman Dale Winter arrived at the meeting at 6:45. Bob Koerselman was absent.

Other's present were city employees Jerry Lode and Tami Kamies.

Mayor Koerselman opened the public hearing for the budget amendment at 5:31p.m.

Council member Jungers introduced Resolution 2021-09 amending the annual budget for fiscal year ending June 30, 2021. There were no written or oral comments from taxpayers and citizens. Council member Alexander seconded the motion to adopt. Roll call vote 3-0-2.

Mayor Koerselman closed the public hearing at 5:33 p.m.

Maintenance Report – Council discussed purchasing a Bobcat toolcat. Beukelman made a motion to purchase the toolcat. Jungers supported. Motion carried 3-0. Council also discusses having Schwebach tree service remove 3 trees in the park that are dead. A discussion was had regarding the water leak that happened on Railroad Street. Tami will prepare a bill for the water that was leaked during this time.

Consent Agenda -Beukelman made a motion for approval of the bills in the amount of 73,243.59, the April financials, the April 12 minutes, the building permits for Randy Godtland and Lori Rohwer, the DOT Agreement for maintenance and appointing council member Alexander to the NW IA Landfill, Tami Kamies to the NW IA Regional Housing, and council member Jungers to the cemetery board. Jungers supported. Motion carried 3-0.

Council discussed moving \$5.00 from the water rate to the sewer rate. This is to help create more sewer revenue in anticipation for the wastewater treatment facility. Beukelman made a motion to make this change. Alexander supported. Motion carried 3-0.

A discussion was had regarding the Local Option Sales Tax the city receives. Council would like to change the way this money can be used from 100% property tax relief to 100% capital improvements. This would allow the money to be used for projects that are done to better the community. Tami will work with the attorney to get the proper paper work filed for this to be on the November ballot.

The street project and parking on the yard's discussion were tabled to next month's meeting.

Council discussed Ordinance 2021-102 amending the city code by adopting a new chapter 18, to create the City Administration Position. The first and second readings were waived. Council member Alexander made a motion to approve. Winter seconded the motion. The ordinance was passed and approved. Roll call vote 4-0-1. A discussion was also had regarding naming Tami as the city administrator. She will be moved to a salaried position.

With no further business Jungers made a motion to adjourn the meeting. Alexander supported. Motion carried 4-0. Meeting was adjourned at 7:10 p.m.
