City of Boyden Minutes of Monthly Council Meeting June 11, 2018

Mayor Laryl Koerselman called the meeting to order at 5:30 p.m.

Council members present were Dale Winter, Kim Ochsendorf, Art Van Bruggen, and Justin Beukelman. Absent was Bob Koerselman.

Others present were city employees Tami Kamies and Blake Snieder.

Mayor and Council Comments – Tami presented to the council the quotes received from the state as well as Williams & Co. in Sheldon to perform the annual audit required by the state. Ochsendorf made a motion that the city will use Williams & Co. to perform the annual audit of the books for FY18 for the city. Beukelman supported. Motion passed 4-0.

Citizen State Bank asked the cities permission to put up reserved parking for the bank signs on the sidewalk in front of the bank. The council approved the request.

Consent Agenda: Councilman Ochsendorf made a motion to approve the May financials, the bills in the amount of \$154,923.82, and the building permit for David Kooiker. Winter supported. Motion passed 4-0.

Beukelman made a motion to approve Resolution 2018-10 for the transferring of funds from the emergency fund to the general fund. Winter supported. Motion passed 4-0.

Resolution 2018-11 approving the subdivision for the Demco First Addition was presented. Beukelman made a motion to approve the resolution. Van Bruggen supported. Motion passed 4-0.

Tami informed the council that the state is requiring anybody who provides a piped water service will now be required to collect a 6% Water Excise Tax instead of the 7% Sales Tax on water. This change will take effect on July 1, 2018.

A discussion was had regarding the debt service money and franchise money available to use. The debt service money will be used to pay down debt. The franchise money that is available will be used to pay down debt as well as help in cost of purchasing new water meters.

With no further business Beukelman made a motion to adjourn the meeting. Winter supported. Motion passed 4-0. Meeting was adjourned at 7:00 p.m.
