City of Boyden Minutes of Monthly Council Meeting October 8, 2018

Mayor Laryl Koerselman called the meeting to order at 5:30 p.m. Council members present were Dale Winter, Kim Ochsendorf, and Justin Beukelman. Bob Koerselman was absent.

Others present were city employees Tami Kamies and Blake Snieder. Art Van Bruggen was also present.

Mayor Koerselman opened the public hearing at 5:30 p.m.

The City Administrator reported that a consultation meeting was duly held and no written recommendations were received from the affected taxing entities. The city administrator also reported that the Urban Renewal Plan is in conformity with the Sioux County Comprehensive Plan. There were no other written or oral objections. The public hearing was closed at 5:35.

Winter introduced Resolution 2018-14 determining an area of the city to be an economic development area, and that the rehabilitation, conservation, redevelopment, development, or a combination thereof, of such area is necessary in the interest of the public health, safety or welfare of the residents of the city; designating such are as appropriated for urban renewal projects: and adopting the urban renewal plan for a proposed Urban Renewal Area No. 4 (Demco 1st Addition). Ochsendorf seconded the motion. Motion passed 3-0.

Ochsendorf made a motion to approve Ordinance 2018-14 stating that the general property taxes levied and collected each year on all property located within the Urban Renewal Area No.4 (Demco 1st Addition), in the city of Boyden, County of Sioux, State of Iowa, by and for the benefit of the State of Iowa, City of Boyden, County of Sioux, Boyden-Hull Community School District, and other taxing districts, be paid to a special fund for payment of principal and interest on loans, monies, advanced to and indebtedness, including bonds issued or to be issued, incurred by the in in connection with the Urban Renewal Area No. 4 (Demco 1st Addition). Beukelman seconded. Motion to pass the first reading of this ordinance. 3-0.

Mayor and council comments (maintenance report):

The city of Boyden council will have a vacant seat and will hold a special election on December 11 to fill the vacancy.

Beukelman made a motion to have Blake order a new door for the shop from DK Door. Winter supported. Motion passed 3-0.

A discussion was had regarding purchasing new pipe for the sewer project that Boer & Sons will be doing. Ochsendorf made a motion to order sch 26 pipe thru Boer & Sons. Winter supported. Motion carried 3-0. Lyon & Sioux Rural water will be inspecting the water tower for the city.

Consent Agenda: Councilman Ochsendorf made a motion to approve the September financials, the bills in the amount of \$47,687.68. Beukelman supported. Motion passed 3-0.

Beukelman made a motion to approve the Urban Renewal Report prepared by Kamies to be correct. Ochsendorf seconded the motion. Motion carried 3-0.

Winter made a motion to consent that the Annual Financial Report prepared by Kamies was to be correct. Ochsendorf supported. Motion passed 3-0.

With no further business Ochsendorf made a motion to adjourn the meeting. Beukelman supported. Motion passed 3-0. Meeting was adjourned at 7:15 p.m.
