Council discussed the process of annexation. They have table this and will look at it at a later date.

The paving of Grant Street just north of Farmers Feed was discussed. The council wants to look at this at the January meeting for further discussion.

Councilman Winter made a motion to approve the Annual Urban Renewal Report for fiscal year 2019. Ochsendorf supported. Motion carried 4-0.

A motion to approve that Deryck Hoogendoorn can take the EMT class was made by councilman Beukelman. Alexander supported the motion. Motion carried 4-0.

Discussion was had regarding a possible new business that may be coming to Boyden. The council decided that the city would take the responsibility to make sure the sewer and water hook up is up to the current empty lot if the persons decide to pursue the business.

With no further business Winter made a motion to adjourn the meeting. Alexander supported. Motion carried 4-0. Meeting was adjourned at 7:30 p.m.
