Justin Beukelman left the meeting at 6:00 pm.

Winter made a motion to approve the Annual Financial Report for FY2020. The report will be published in the newspaper and then reported to the state by December 1. Jungers supported. Motion carried 3-0.

Council discussed the Industrial Sewer Rate Structure. Tami will put numbers together and this will be discussed again at the December council meeting.

A discussion was had regarding the wetland/pond project. At this time no decisions have been made. This project will be further discussed at a later date.

With no further business Ochsendorf made a motion to adjourn the meeting. Jungers supported. Motion carried 3-0. Meeting was adjourned at 6:40 p.m.
