Minutes of Monthly Council Meeting  
August 12, 2019

Mayor Laryl Koerselman called the meeting to order at 5:30 p.m.

Council members present were Dale Winter, Kim Ochsendorf, Justin Beukelman, and Nathan Alexander.

Bob Koerselman was absent.

Others present were Wayne Jungers, Robert Sietstra, Robin Jungers, and city employees Blake Snieder and Tami Kamies.

Wayne Jungers discussed with council the parking of vehicles over 10 ton on city streets. He feels that the city needs to be more consistent in informing people that parking such vehicles on city streets is not allowed. The council agrees and has requested that the citizens need to also help in informing the city where this is happening so action can be taken.

Robin Jungers and Robert Sietstra approached the council with their concern of the water issues that are happening to their homes due to the neighboring property. The council has previously spoke with the homeowner but the action that was discussed at that time has not taken place. The council will work with Robin and Robert to approach the homeowner so a solution can be made.

Blake presented the city maintenance report which included the purchase of a different paint sprayer. Discussion regarding replaced water shut off valves in home owners property that don't work and a few areas in town where street repair and culvert repairs need to happen. He also talked about removing a few of the trees in the park that are dead.

Consent Agenda: Councilman Beukelman made a motion to pass the July Financials, the minutes from the July 8 & 15 minutes, bills in the amount of \$74,176.58 and building permits for SIG, Carl Bonestroo, Jonathan Draayer, and Brent Steven. Ochsendorf supported. Motion carried 4-0.

The council discussed the making of a park board according to the City Ordinance. The council will be accepting applications from anybody that would like to possibly be part of the cities park board. The council will then select 5 people that will serve on the board.

With no further business Beukelman made a motion to adjourn the meeting. Alexander supported. Motion carried 4-0. Meeting was adjourned at 7:45 p.m.
