~ Reminders ~

Garbage Pickup Reminder: Each property on the weekly garbage route is allowed (2) 35 gallon containers each week. Each container is not to exceed 75 pounds.

Camper/ RV/ Trailer Parking: Campers, RV’s, and trailers **should not be parked more than 48 hours on the street** at any location within the City. The City will contact the sheriff’s office to ticket those in violation of the 48 hour limit. Those in violation will be ticketed \$10 per day that the camper, RV, or trailer remains on the street.

Dog Ordinances: Please be advised that the City has ordinances which govern dogs at large, unleashed, and a noise ordinance for barking. The Sioux County Sheriff’s Dept. should be notified if you have a dog complaint at 737-2280.

Animal Regulation Ordinance: Reminder to residents: City Code 55.17 regulates the number of animals that can be kept on a property as follows:

- a. It is unlawful for a person to keep or maintain at any one location more than two of the following types of animals: dogs, cats, ferrets or rabbits, which animals are more than six months old or are animals that are from more than one litter and are more than 3 months old, unless otherwise permitted by written permit from the City Council.
- b. Any animals kept in violation of this section of Code may be immediately removed from the property and impounded.
