~ Reminders ~

Garbage Pickup Reminder: Garbage will be picked up every Wednesday. Recycling will be picked up the first and third Wednesday of each month.

Camper/ RV/ Trailer Parking: Campers, RV’s, and trailers should not be parked more than 48 hours on the street at any location within the City. The City will contact the sheriff’s office to ticket those in violation of the 48-hour limit. Those in violation will be ticketed \$10 per day that the camper, RV, or trailer remains on the street.

Dog Ordinances: Please be advised that the City has ordinances which govern dogs at large, unleashed, and a noise ordinance for barking. The Sioux County Sheriff’s Dept. should be notified if you have a dog complaint at 737-2280.

Animal Regulation Ordinance: Reminder to residents: City Code 55.17 regulates the number of animals that can be kept on a property as follows:

- a. It is unlawful for a person to keep or maintain at any one location more than two of the following types of animals: dogs, cats, ferrets or rabbits, which animals are more than six months old or are animals that are from more than one litter and are more than 3 months old, unless otherwise permitted by written permit from the City Council.
- b. Any animals kept in violation of this section of Code may be immediately removed from the property and impounded.
